- The informal discussion sessions last about an hour. They are designed to encourage friendly collaboration between students and to generate interesting discussion about points of interpretation in horary charts with a known conclusion.
- A discussion chart PDF will be available for download the week before the session. This contains the relevant chart data and background to the problem, and the question asked. The session will stimulate student-led opinions and discussion on the chart, with the outcome revealed after all students who wish to contribute have had the opportunity to do so.
- A formal write-up of the horary judgement and outcome will be available in a follow-up PDF shortly after the session ends.
- The Zoom session will be recorded for students unable to attend. As with all our in-course training videos, this is not available for download, and no part of it will be shared outside of the STA course.
